Medical Updates

Haley (Ling Chaxun) is a two-year-old who has been living in the House of Blessings for the past 20 months, and was recently diagnosed with an inguinal hernia. On Oct. 20 she had a successful hernia repair, and two days later returned to Shepherd's Field where she's doing very well.



Ethan (Niu Kaien) is an 11-month-old boy with a cleft lip and palate and a left ear deformity who has been with us since July at Zachry House. He was also thought to have a heart defect but our evaluation at the heart hospital showed his heart is normal. He had his cleft lip successfully repaired during the week of Nov. 15, then returned to Shepherd's Field several days later, where he's doing well in the post-op recovery period. He will get his palate repair surgery in four months.



Hugo (Wang Longhe) is a 15-month-old with a cleft lip and palate. He's been with us since March, living in the House of Love. His lip was successfully repaired in June and the palate operation took place during the week of Nov. 15. He had a successful operation, did well in the post-op, and returned to Shepherd's Field on Nov. 18.

Eleven-month-old **Moka (Zhang Moka)** met her family – also from the U.S. – on the same day as Bea. She was part of the House of Blessings family for half a year. A resident of the House of Peace for the past six months, 16-month-old **Emma Grace (Liu Rongjia)** met her new family on Oct. 24, and has gone to live in Edgewood, Kentucky, where she has three brothers – two older and one younger. Avery has two older brothers and an older sister. With these five adoptions we now have a total of 26 for the year. Shepherd's Field Seeking Sponsors for Orphans



The Philip Hayden Foundation is conducting a child sponsorship drive to mobilize 500 new sponsors for the children at Shepherd's Field. The cost of caring for each child has risen dramatically due to the higher prices of food, supplies, utilities and especially our nanny staff. Recently we've had to increase wages and benefits to our nannies in order to meet the standard set by the Chinese government, so to cover these increased costs, we're raising the number of sponsors needed from 10 to 15 per child. Sponsorship costs \$35.00 per month per child, and provides food, shelter, clothing, education, basic medical care and around-the-clock care from a loving nanny to an orphan in need. We cannot accept any new children

until more sponsors are found for the children already living here, so your help is greatly needed. Construction Update: 1 Floor Down, 3 To Go



With the winter upon us here in Northern China we've had to wrap up this year's construction on the new Shepherd's Field Vocational Training Center. The first of four floors have been built with the funds we've raised for the project to date, but we'll need to raise an additional US\$588,880 to finish building the center. Construction will resume next year on March 15, when we'll need US\$183,470 to complete the second floor. Without question, your support is needed and appreciated.
